The Project Itinerary: Four Waypoints to Connection



Waypoint 1: Setting the Coordinates

The Control Center

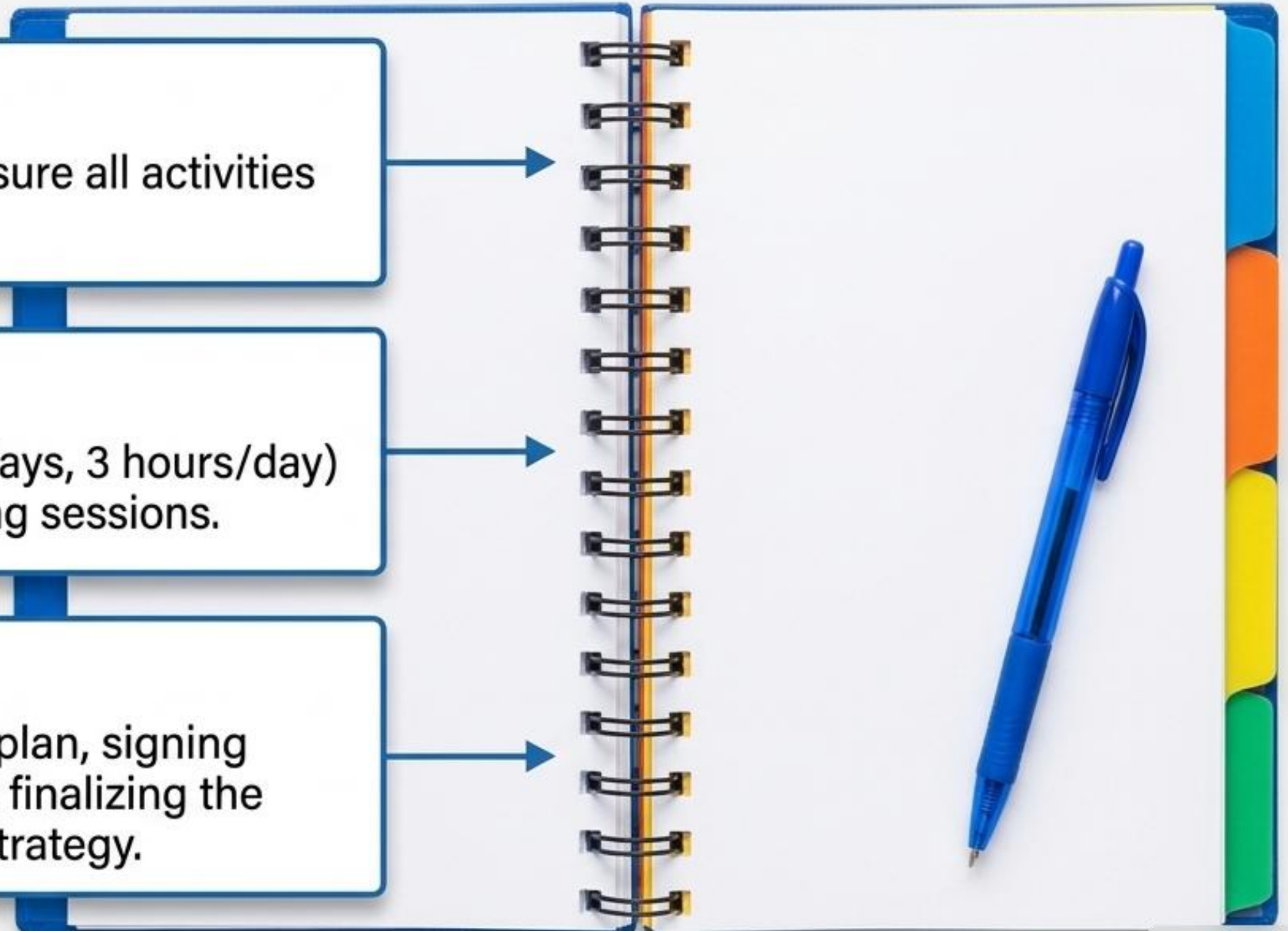
Coordinated by Aluzina to ensure all activities map to the master plan.

The Meetings

1 intensive online kick-off (2 days, 3 hours/day)
+ 16 monthly progress tracking sessions.

The Outputs

Drafting the implementation plan, signing partnership agreements, and finalizing the project-wide dissemination strategy.



Waypoint 2: Digital Upskilling in Granada



The Event

A 5-day intensive Learning, Teaching, and Training Activity (LTTA) in Granada, Spain.

The Attendees

6 representatives per organization. Celei and Klap preparing to lead digital transformation.

The Ripple Effect

These participants will return to train 20 cultural and educational entities in total (10 per country).

Knowledge & Skills

Mastering Area 2 (Communication & Collaboration) and Area 3 (Digital Content Creation, copyright, and licensing).

Navigating the DigComp dimension of competence—spanning 8 levels of digital fluency.

Connecting digital literacy to lifelong learning, media literacy, and participatory citizenship.

Waypoint 3: Building the Network in Italy



The Event

A 5-day Study Visit to Rome, Italy
(6 people per entity).

The Curriculum

Designing collaboration agreements, governance models, financing, and integrating new entities.

Real-World Action

Visiting a Roman social cooperative to see cross-sector work in action, followed by a youth volunteer activity.

The Output

A joint action plan and formalized collaboration agreement.

Waypoint 4: Launching the Collaborative Platform

Co-Creation

Built and tested alongside all the newly trained organizations.

Content by the Community

Organizations will upload their own videos, photos, and event details using the digital skills they just mastered.

The Goal

A fully operational, real-world environment where young people can instantly discover cultural and educational offerings in their region.



Open Access: The Rules of the Platform



No Payment Gateways

The platform itself is entirely free to use and browse.



Priority to Free Programs

Top billing is given to free Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps (CES) activities.



Non-Profit Exceptions

Paid events are permitted only for non-profits that use them for self-financing. Tickets will be handled via external channels, keeping our platform's focus strictly on discovery.
